- 4. Title Apple Board
- 5. Summary/Purpose: The bill updates the Apple Board to reflect the results of the 2003 referendum, which discontinued the excise tax on apples. The second enactment clause repeals Article 3 of Chapter 23 of Title 3.1, Code of Virginia, *Referendum on Continuation of the Levy of Excise Tax on Apples*.
- 6. The bill has no fiscal impact.
- Budget amendment necessary: No, any necessary adjustments to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' appropriation may be made administratively. See item 8.
- 8. Fiscal implications: The bill eliminates the collection of excise taxes, but permits the Apple Board to expend the balance remaining in the Apple Fund. The balance in the fund is approximately \$16,000.
- 9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Apple Board, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
- 10. Technical amendment necessary: No.
