4. Title: Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; Board for Asbestos, Lead and Home Inspectors; summary suspension of licenses

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill provides authority for the Board for Asbestos, Lead, and Home Inspectors to order summary suspension of a license or the approval of any accredited training program, training manager or principal instructor without a hearing if a licensee's, training program, training manager's or principal instructor's continued operation constitutes a substantial danger to the public health or safety. The bill also provides that proceedings for a hearing must be instituted simultaneously with the suspension.
