**4. Title** Motorcycle rider safety training centers.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This legislation proposes to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-1188 through 46.2-1192 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 46.2-1190.1 through 46.2-1190.7 to provide for licensure of motorcycle rider safety training centers, instructors, etc., by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal implications:** Currently the Department of Motor Vehicles oversees the providers of motorcycle safety training courses as part of a contractual relationship. This legislation allows private and public entities to offer these courses subject to being licensed by the department. While the oversight relationship changes from a contractual relationship to a licensing one, the department advises that it sees no reason that its costs should increase. However, in the event that those costs do increase, the DMV believes that it can absorb the increase.
