4. Title Motor vehicles with nitrous oxygen-supplied engines; prohibited

5. Summary/Purpose:

Prohibits operation on the public highways of passenger cars whose engines are supplied with nitrous oxide. Violations constitute Class 3 misdemeanors (fine up to \$500).

6. Fiscal Impact Estimate are: Final

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: It is not possible at this time to determine how many persons would commit a violation. The maximum fine for Class 3 misdemeanors is \$500. Any revenue generated from the enactment of this bill would be deposited into the Literary Fund. It is anticipated that the revenue generated would be minimal.
