**4. Title**            Motor vehicles with nitrous oxygen-supplied engines; prohibited

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Prohibits operation on the public highways of passenger cars whose engines are supplied with nitrous oxide. Violations constitute Class 3 misdemeanors (fine up to \$500).

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimate are:** Final

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** It is not possible at this time to determine how many persons would be convicted for violating the provisions of this legislation. The maximum fine for Class 3 misdemeanors is \$500. Any revenue generated from the enactment of this bill would be deposited into the Literary Fund. It is anticipated that the revenue generated would be minimal.
