4. Title Registration of pharmacy technicians in free clinics

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill requires the Board of Pharmacy to waive the initial registration fee and the first examination fee for the Board-approved examination for a pharmacy technician applicant who works as a pharmacy technician exclusively in a free clinic pharmacy. If such applicant fails the examination, he must be responsible for any subsequent fees to retake the examination. A person registered pursuant to this subsection shall be issued a limited-use registration. A pharmacy technician with a limited-use registration must not perform pharmacy technician tasks in any setting other than a free clinic pharmacy. The Board must also waive renewal fees for such limited-use registrations. A pharmacy technician with a limited-use registration may convert to an unlimited registration by paying the current renewal fee.
