4. Title Nurse Licensure Compact; holder of multistate licensure privilege

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill clarifies and reinforces the regulatory authority of the Board of Nursing and the Department of Health Professions over persons issued a multistate licensure privilege to practice nursing in Virginia. This bill renders provisions relating to discipline, practice protocols, and other scope of practice requirements applicable to any person holding a multistate licensure privilege issued under the Nurse Licensure Compact. The Compact will become effective on January 2005. As amended, the bill would require the department promulgate emergency regulations.
