Currently, it is a Class 1 misdemeanor to impersonate a law enforcement officer. The proposed legislation would increase the offense to a Class 6 felony if a person impersonated a law enforcement officer while committing any one of the following offenses: murder, mob or gang crimes, kidnapping, assault, robbery, extortion, and sexual assault.

8. Fiscal implications:

Pursuant to §30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission estimates a fiscal impact of \$4,435 (the highest annual cost over the next six years). The amount is based on the projection that the legislation will result in 0.20 additional inmates being incarcerated in prison.
