Requires the State Board of Elections (SBE) to provide instructions for compliance with disclosure requirements to be available in printed form on request and to be posted on its official website. The instructions shall be reviewed by the Office of the Attorney General for accuracy and completeness.

**8. Fiscal implications:** The first year, the fiscal implications will affect the time that it takes to develop the new document and the cost of providing paper copies to those who request copies. SBE estimates it costs at between \$100 and \$250 annually which will be absorbed by the agency. The document will be made available on State Board of Elections webpage for free download and printing. Local electoral boards will absorb minor fiscal impact for providing copies free of charge to all who request the document. SBE cannot determine the fiscal impact for the Office of the Attorney General's responsibility to review the document to ensure accuracy and completeness.
