4. Title Professions and occupations; unlawful acts; penalties

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill includes public agencies and local school boards specifically as "entities" that must not engage in any enumerated unlawful acts. The bill modifies the provision relating to violating any statute or regulation governing the practice of any regulated profession or occupation to include "facilitating" the violation of any statute or regulation governing the practice of any regulated profession or occupation and to cover any statutory or regulatory requirement for direction and supervision of the practice of any regulated profession or occupation.

6. Fiscal Impact: The bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation or the Department of Health Professionals.
