**4. Title**         Sale of veteran's memorials or grave markers; penalty.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Any person who sells or offers for sale any memorial or grave marker of one or more deceased persons who served in the military service of the Commonwealth, the United States, or any of the states thereof, is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.

**8. Fiscal implications:**

Anyone convicted of a Class 3 misdemeanor is subject to a fine of up to \$500. The number of people that might be convicted under these provisions is unknown, which makes it impossible to make a reliable estimate of how much revenue this bill would generate if passed. Any additional revenue that might be collected would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
