Summary/Purpose: The bill provides that a contractor licensed by the Board for Contractors is not required to get an architect's or engineer's license to bid on or negotiate design-build contracts or perform services, other than architectural, engineering or land surveying services under a design-build contract. The bill provides, however, that the architectural, engineering or land surveying services offered or rendered in connection with such contracts shall only be rendered by a licensed architect, professional engineer or land surveyor.

6. Fiscal impact: The bill has no fiscal impact.
