4. Title Homeowners insurance deductibles.

5. Summary/Purpose: Requires an insurer to provide a written notice whenever it unilaterally changes the deductible on a policy written to insure an owner-occupied dwelling. The notice must state that the deductible has changed and explain how the new deductible will be applied. The law prohibits the insurer from changing the deductible except at renewal, and the law only applies to policies renewed on or after October 1, 2004.
