## 5. Summary/Purpose:

Provides that any person who attends a meeting of an alcohol safety action program, pursuant to an order of the court under § 18.2-271.1, while he is under the influence of alcohol or other self-administered intoxicants, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a \$5,000 fine and permanent revocation of his operator's license and of his privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the Commonwealth.

- **8. Fiscal implications:** It is not possible at this time to determine how many persons would be convicted under this statute. Any revenue generated from the enactment of this bill would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
