4. Title: Notice of proposals for methadone clinics required.

5. Summary/Purpose: Upon receipt of a proposal or application for a license to operate a facility for the provision of detoxification, treatment or rehabilitation of drug addicts through the use of the controlled substance methadone or other such controlled substances, this bill requires the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services to notify localities of the proposed location.

8. Fiscal implications: There will be minimal impact. It is projected that four to six notifications and subsequent follow-up letters will be needed per year.
