- **5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill codifies current Board of Education authority to provide, within teacher licensure regulations, provisions addressing license revocation and renewal that include procedures for the revocation of a teacher license upon receipt from a local school board of (i) a petition for such revocation and (ii) the record of the local school board hearing regarding such petition. The Superintendent of Public Instruction is to review and make recommendations regarding such petition and record, upon the request of the Board, and the Board shall make a final determination regarding such revocation within 60 days of receipt of the petition.
