4. Title Hearings for teacher dismissal and licensure revocation.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill requires the Board of education's regulations on teacher licensure to include the requirements for application for and the issuance, denial, renewal and reinstatement of licenses and a single due process hearing by which the Board may suspend or revoke such licenses. The Board's regulations must include the appropriate grounds for such suspensions or revocations and a mechanism for filing and processing complaints against licensees.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill codifies current practice. The substitute version no longer has a fiscal impact for Department of Education since there is no longer an emergency regulation clause, and the department is already addressing the requirements of the bill through existing regulation.
