5. Summary/Purpose:

SB 223 would delete the requirement that any statement indicating racial designation be omitted from reports of divorces and annulments required to be filed by the clerk of court with the State Registrar regarding a final decree of divorce or annulment, and in marriage and adoption records. Information pertaining to racial designation is essential in establishing health histories, and in conducting anthropological, sociological, and genealogical research, particularly among racial and ethnic minority persons.
