4. Title: Milk Commission

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill merges the Milk Commission with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, as directed by Item 127 of Chapter 1042 of the 2003 Acts of Assembly (2003 Appropriation Act).

6. No Fiscal impact.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No, the appropriation for the Milk Commission was moved to Item 106 in the 2003 Appropriation Act, and established as a separate subprogram, Regulation of Milk and Dairy Products Wholesomeness (55403), within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.

8. Fiscal implications: The bill has no fiscal impact on the Milk Commission or the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The bill codifies the merger that was implemented through the 2003 Appropriation Act. The merger did not reduce the budget for the Milk Commission.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Milk Commission, Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
