**5. Summary/Purpose:** Restricts service of a summons to only a sheriff, his deputy or a police officer in any case in which custody or visitation of a minor child or children is at issue and the summons is issued for a teacher or other school personnel who is not a party to the proceeding. The bill also doubles the fee to \$24 for process and service in any case in which custody or visitation of a minor child or children is at issue.
