	This bill would set the recordation tax on leases of communication towers or communication tower sites to \$75. This bill would also set the tax on the recordation of each lease to affix communications equipment or antenna to a communications tower to \$15 for each tower that the equipment or antenna is to be affixed. Further, this bill would set the recordation tax on the leases of oil and gas rights to \$25, and the recordation tax on the leases of coal and other mineral rights to \$50. Finally, this bill would set the recordation tax on leases of outdoor advertising signs owned by a person engaged in the ousiness of outdoor advertising licensed by the Virginia Department of Transportation to \$25.

The recordation tax for recording a lease is 15 cents per \$100 of the consideration or value contracted. Currently, the recordation tax for the recording of oil and gas rights leases cannot exceed \$25 and the recordation tax for the recording of coal or other mineral rights leases cannot exceed \$50. The recordation tax for recording leases on outdoor advertising signs owned by a person engaged in the business of ourtdoor advertising licensed by the Virginia Department of Transportation cannot exceed \$25.

This bill would set the recordation tax on leases of communication towers or communication tower sites from 15 cents per \$100 of the consideration or value contracted to \$75. This bill would also set the tax on the recordation of each lease to affix communications equipment or antenna to a communications tower to \$15 for each tower that the equipment or antenna is to be affixed. Further, this bill would set the recordation tax on the leases of oil and gas rights from any amount up to \$25 to \$25 and the recordation tax on the leases of coal and other mineral rights from any amount up to \$50 to \$50. Finally, this bill would set the recordation tax on leases of outdoor advertising signs owned by a person engaged in the business of ourtdoor advertising licensed by the Virginia Department of Transportation from any amount up to \$25 to \$25.
