3. Committee House: Education

4. Title Written contracts for school board employees.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill requires school boards to have a written contract with each person who is (i) employed on a full-time or part-time basis for a term of at least 10 months and (ii) not required to hold a license issued by the Board of Education. Written notice of the offer of such employment must be given to these persons not more than 10 days after the first regular school board meeting following the adoption of the school board budget by the appropriating body. This provision applies to various classified employees, such as bus drivers, cafeteria workers, and janitors. Some school boards contract for some of these services rather than hire the individuals to perform the work.

6. Fiscal Impact: See Item 8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The provisions of this bill could impact local school divisions in developing and administering this contract process. This impact cannot be quantified since practices regarding the issuance of written contracts may vary among school divisions.
