Fiscal implications: This proposal raises the authority for public bodies to use competitive negotiations as a contracting method for contracts that alter, repair, renovate, or demolish buildings from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000. The proposal also deletes the requirement for review and approval of design-build or construction management contracts by the Design-Build/Construction Management Review Board. This second requirement pertains to public bodies other than the Commonwealth.
