4. Title Business entities; changes in provisions.

5. Summary/Purpose: Amends the Stock Corporation Act, the Nonstock Corporation Act, the Limited Partnership Act, the Limited Liability Company Act, the Business Trust Act, and the Limited Liability Partnership Act to clarify provisions relating to the reinstatement of administratively terminated entities. The changes also (i) authorize limited liability company operating agreements to provide for contractual appraisal rights, arbitration and exclusive jurisdiction, and multiple classes of members and managers; (ii) clarify the liability of limited liability companies to indemnify members, managers, and other agents; (iii) permit limited liability companies to engage in any business, purpose, or activity, regardless of whether the activity constitutes a business; and (iv) conform charging order provisions of the limited liability company, limited partnership, and partnership statutes. Also makes other technical changes to the limited liability company, partnership, and limited partnership acts.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are minimal. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal implications: There is an estimated impact on the State Corporation Commission's Clerk's Office of approximately \$15,120. This amount can be absorbed by the agency. The bill will require several modifications to the Clerk's Office Information System (27 days x 8 hours = 216 x \$70/hr = \$15,120).
