5. Summary/Purpose: Increases and clarifies some of the fees charged by sheriffs for (i) out-of-state service, (ii) sheriff's commission on executing a writ, and (iii) collection of expenses of advertising.

8. Fiscal implications: It is not possible to estimate the impact on the Commonwealth's revenue resulting from the proposal because data is collected in aggregate, not by each individual fee. However, any increase in revenue (with the exception of the portion associated with the Sheriffs' commissions) would be deposited in the general fund in accordance with §15.2-1609.3.
