## 5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires that upon retirement, a law-enforcement officer be issued a photo identification card indicating that he is a retired law-enforcement officer. The bill also requires that such identification cards be provided upon request to law-enforcement officers who retired before July 1, 2004. Creates Section 9.1-1000.

- 8. Fiscal implications: The Department of State Police anticipates a minimal fiscal impact due to this proposal that can be absorbed with current funding. The Virginia State Police presently issues a retiree identification card with concealed weapon carry authorization, although it does not have a photo attached. Currently, there are 1,060 retired State Police Officers, that may, at their option, elect to have the newer card issued. The cost to produce each ID card is approximately \$1.05 each. Provided all retires desired a picture ID card, the total cost for current retirees would be \$1,113.00. Further, the Department of State Police has approximately 50 sworn employees retire each year that would be eligible for this ID Card.
