

VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY -- 2005 SESSION

CHAPTER 488

An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia, relating to distribution of materials to and solicitation of funds from motorists on secondary highways.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-931 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-931. Certain localities may prohibit distribution of handbills, etc., solicitation of contributions and sale of merchandise on highways within their boundaries.

Arlington and Henrico Counties *and the Town of Vienna* are hereby authorized to adopt ordinances prohibiting *or regulating*:

1. The distribution of handbills, leaflets, bulletins, literature, advertisements, or similar material to the drivers of motor vehicles or passengers therein on secondary *and urban* highways located within ~~such counties~~ *their boundaries*;

2. The solicitation of contributions of any nature from the drivers of motor vehicles or passengers therein on secondary *and urban* highways located within ~~such counties~~ *their boundaries*;

3. The sale of merchandise or the attempted sale of merchandise to the drivers of motor vehicles or passengers therein on secondary *and urban* highways located within ~~such counties~~ *their boundaries*.

Ordinances adopted pursuant to this section may provide that any person violating the provisions of such ordinances shall be guilty of a traffic infraction.
