6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 8.01-128 of the Code of Virginia, relating to verdict and judgment;
7	damages.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 8.01-128 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 8.01-128. Verdict and judgment; damages.
11	A. If it appear appears that the plaintiff was forcibly or unlawfully turned out of possession, or that
12	it was unlawfully detained from him, the verdict or judgment shall be for the plaintiff for the premises,
13	or such part thereof as may be found to have been so held or detained. The verdict or judgment shall
14	also be for such damages as the plaintiff may prove to have been sustained by him by reason of such
15	forcible or unlawful entry, or unlawful detention, of such premises, and such rent as he may prove to
16	have been owing to him, provided such damages and rent claimed shall not exceed the jurisdictional
17	amount of the court in which the action is tried.
18	B. The plaintiff may, alternatively, receive a final, appealable judgment for possession of the
19	property unlawfully entered or unlawfully detained and be issued a writ of possession, and continue the
20	case for up to 90 days to establish final rent and damages. If under this section an appeal is taken as
20 21	to possession, the entire case shall be considered appealed. The plaintiff shall, in the instance of a
22	continuance taken under this section, mail to the defendant at the defendant's last known address at
22 23	
	least 15 days prior to the continuance date a notice advising of (i) the continuance date; (ii) the
24	amounts of final rent and damages; and (iii) that the plaintiff is seeking judgment for additional sums.
