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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

An Act to amend and reenact § 22.1-279.8 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school safety audits. 2

3 4 Approved 5 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 7 1. That § 22.1-279.8 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 22.1-279.8. School safety audits and school crisis and emergency management plans required. 9 A. For the purposes of this section, unless the context requires otherwise: 10 "School crisis and emergency management plan" means the essential procedures, operations, and assignments required to prevent, manage, and respond to a critical event or emergency, including natural 11 disasters involving fire, flood, tornadoes, or other severe weather; loss or disruption of power, water, 12 13 communications or shelter; bus or other accidents; medical emergencies; student or staff member deaths; 14 explosions; bomb threats; gun, knife or other weapons threats; spills or exposures to hazardous substances; the presence of unauthorized persons or trespassers; the loss, disappearance or kidnapping of 15 a student; hostage situations; violence on school property or at school activities; incidents involving acts 16 of terrorism; and other incidents posing a serious threat of harm to students, personnel, or facilities. 17 18 "School safety audit" means a written assessment of the safety conditions in each public school to (i) 19 identify and, if necessary, develop solutions for physical safety concerns, including building security 20 issues and (ii) identify and evaluate any patterns of student safety concerns occurring on school property or at school-sponsored events. Solutions and responses shall include recommendations for structural 21 22 adjustments, changes in school safety procedures, and revisions to the school board's standards for 23 student conduct. 24 B. The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall develop a list of items to be reviewed and 25 evaluated in the school safety audits required by this section. Such items shall include those incidents 26 reported to school authorities pursuant to § 22.1-279.3:1. 27 The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall prescribe a standardized report format for school 28 safety audits, additional reporting criteria, and procedures for report submission, which may include 29 instructions for electronic submission. 30 Each local school board shall require all schools under its supervisory control to annually conduct 31 school safety audits as defined in this section and consistent with such list. 32 The results of such school safety audits shall be made public within 90 days of completion. The 33 local school board shall retain authority to withhold or limit the release of any security plans and 34 specific vulnerability assessment components as provided in subdivision 7 of § 2.2-3705.2. Each school 35 shall maintain a copy of the school safety audit, which may exclude such security plans and vulnerability assessment components, within the office of the school principal and shall make a copy of 36 37 such report available for review upon written request. 38 Each school shall submit a copy of its school safety audit to the relevant school division 39 superintendent. The division superintendent shall collate and submit all such school safety audits, in the 40 prescribed format and manner of submission, to the Virginia Center for School Safety. 41 C. The school board may establish a school safety audit committee to consist of representatives of 42 parents, teachers, local law-enforcement agencies, judicial and public safety personnel, and the 43 community at large. The school safety audit committee shall evaluate, in accordance with the directions 44 of the local school board, the safety of each school and submit a plan for improving school safety at a 45 public meeting of the local school board. 46 D. Each school board shall ensure that every school that it supervises shall develop a written school crisis and emergency management plan, consistent with the definition provided in this section. The 47 Department of Education and the Virginia Center for School Safety shall provide technical assistance to **48** the school divisions of the Commonwealth in the development of the school crisis and emergency 49 50 management plans.

Upon consultation with local school boards, division superintendents, the Virginia Center for School 51 52 Safety, and the Coordinator of Emergency Management, the Board of Education shall develop, and may 53 revise as it deems necessary, a model school crisis and emergency management plan for the purpose of 54 assisting the public schools in Virginia in developing viable, effective crisis and emergency management 55 plans. Such model shall set forth recommended effective procedures and means by which parents can contact the relevant school or school division regarding the location and safety of their school children 56 57 and by which school officials may contact parents, with parental approval, during a critical event or

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58 emergency.
