7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**8 **1. That § 29.1-336 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

9 § 29.1-336. Carrying licenses and certificates; penalty.

10 A. Every person who is issued a hunting, trapping, or fishing license ~~must~~ *shall* carry the license on
11 his person while hunting, trapping, or fishing. Persons who have been issued such licenses and fail to
12 carry them when required shall be guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor.

13 B. Any person who is 16 years of age or older and who is (i) required to present a certificate of
14 completion in hunter education to obtain a hunting license pursuant to § 29.1-300.1, and (ii) issued a
15 hunting license by telephone, the Internet, or other electronic or computerized means, shall also carry
16 such certificate on his person while hunting.

17 C. Any person who is 12 years of age through 15 years of age, and is issued a hunting license by
18 telephone, the Internet, or other electronic or computerized means, shall carry his certificate of
19 completion in hunter education on his person while hunting, unless he is accompanied and directly
20 supervised by an adult who has, on his person, a valid Virginia hunting license and certificate if
21 required under subsection B.
