6	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
7	1. That § 15.2-951 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
8	§ 15.2-951. Acquisition, disposition and use of personal property by localities generally.
9	Localities, for the purposes of exercising any of their powers and duties and performing any of their
10	functions, may acquire by gift, bequest, purchase, lease, or installment purchase contract; and may own
11	and make use of and may grant security interests in, sell and otherwise dispose of, within and outside
12	the localities, personal property, including any interest, right or estate therein. In any instance where
13	personal property in any of the following categories: school or transit bus fleet, vehicle fleet, or road
14	construction equipment is sold with the intent to lease back the property, when the value of the
15	proposed sale amount exceeds \$2,000,000 approval by the governing body, after notice and a public
16	hearing, shall be required. The public hearing shall be advertised once in a newspaper having general
17	circulation in the locality at least seven days prior to the date set for the hearing. Any debt incurred by
18	a municipality pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be subject to the limitations imposed by
19	Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of Virginia.
