| 11 | 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-63.2 as follows: |
| 12 | § 18.2-63.2. Providing birth control to minor in certain circumstances; penalty. |
| 13 | If any person knows or has reason to believe that a minor is engaging in sexual relations with a |
| 14 | person three years or more older than the minor and such person provides the minor with a |
| 15 | contraceptive or contraceptive device, he shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony. |
| 16 | 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or |
| 17 | commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot |
| 18 | be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and \$0 for periods |

of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
