9 Whereas the General Assembly finds that the financing of the museums and arts and cultural
10 facilities in Virginia authorized herein are in the public interest of the Commonwealth and its citizens
11 and will thereby provide a public benefit to the Commonwealth through enhancing the general welfare
12 and quality of life of all Virginians, now, therefore,

13 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1.§ 1. That pursuant to § 2.2-2264 of the Code of Virginia, the General Assembly hereby authorizes the 14 15 Virginia Public Building Authority to undertake the construction, improvement, and furnishing of the following projects including, without limitation, constructing, improving, furnishing, maintaining, 16 acquiring, and renovating buildings, facilities, improvements and land therefor; and to exercise any and 17 all powers granted to it by law in connection therewith, including the power to finance all or any 18 portion of the cost thereof by the issuance of revenue bonds in a principal amount not to exceed 19 20 \$85,625,000 plus amounts needed to fund issuance costs, reserve funds, original issue discount, interest 21 prior to and during acquisition, construction or renovation and for one year after completion thereof, 22 and other financing expenses.
