| 13 | Any person who, by negligence so gross, wanton and culpable as to show a reckless disregard of |
| 14 | human life, causes bodily injury to another, is guilty of a Class 5 felony. |
| 15 | 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or |
| 16 | commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot |
| 17 | be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be |
