10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 54.1-2910:01 as follows:
12	§ 54.1-2910:01. Practitioner information provided to patients.
13	Doctors of medicine, osteopathy, and podiatry shall make available to patients the following
14	information in a written statement in any primary and secondary practice settings:
15	1. Procedures to access information on the doctor compiled by the Board of Medicine pursuant to
16	§ 54.1-2910.1;
17	2. A list of the doctor's charges for his 20 most commonly performed procedure codes;
18	3. A list of health insurance plans accepted by the doctor and managed care health insurance plans
19	in which the doctor participates;
20	4. Notice that if he is not covered by a health insurance plan that the doctor accepts or a managed
21	care health insurance plan in which the doctor participates, the patient may be subject to the doctor's
22	full charge; and
23	5. A list of the fees charged and the services to which they are attributable if the doctor charges
24	"administrative access fees" for services not covered by a health insurance or managed care health
25	insurance plan. "Administrative access fees" means charges imposed by the doctor in addition to
26	deductibles and co-payments that may be charged to a patient pursuant to a contract with a health
27	insurance or managed care health insurance plan.
