

VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY — CHAPTER

An Act to amend and reenact § 24.2-304.02 of the Code of Virginia, relating to composition of certain House of Delegates districts.

Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**1. That § 24.2-304.02 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 24.2-304.02. House of Delegates districts; composition of certain districts.

Subject to the provisions of subsections A, B, and C of § 24.2-304.01, the following House of Delegates districts shall be comprised as follows. References to precincts and parts of precincts are to precincts as listed in the 2000 Census reports.

First. All of Lee and Scott Counties; part of Washington County comprised of the Burson Place, Mendota, Valley Institute, Wallace Part 3, and Wallace Part 1 Precincts and part of the Greendale Precinct; and part of Wise County comprised of the East Stone Gap and Clinch Valley Precincts and part of the Big Stone Gap Precinct.

Second. All of Dickenson County; all of the City of Norton; part of Russell County comprised of the Copper Creek, Moccasin, South Castlewood, Cleveland, Dante, North Castlewood, Cooks Mill, Daughertys, Elk Garden, and Lebanon Precincts and part of the Honaker Precinct; and part of Wise County comprised of the Appalachia, Dorchester, Guest River, West Pound, North Coeburn, Wise, East Pound, South Coeburn, and St. Paul Precincts and part of the Big Stone Gap Precinct.

Sixth. All of Bland County; part of Giles County comprised of the Glen Lyn, Rich Creek, Narrows, Pearisburg, Staffordsville, White Gate, Sugar Run, Eggleston, Pembroke, and Hatfield Precincts; part of Pulaski County comprised of the Belspring, New River, West Cloyd, Draper, South Pulaski, Newbern, Massie, Walker, and Robinson Precincts and part of the Dublin Precinct; part of Tazewell County comprised of the Springville and Graham Precincts; and part of Wythe County comprised of the Royal Oak, Evansham, Pine Ridge, Spiller, Withers, and Max Meadows Precincts and part of the Evergreen Precinct.

Seventh. All of the City of Radford; part of Montgomery County comprised of the B-2, B-3, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, D-1, D-2, D-3 Part 1, D-4, D-5, E-1, and E-2 Precincts; part of Pulaski County comprised of the Hiwasee 302/Snowville 304 Precinct and part of the Dublin Precinct; and Montgomery A.

Nineteenth. All of the City of Bedford; part of Bedford County comprised of the Stewartsville, Hardy, Otter Hill, Cove, Big Island, Sedalia, Kelso, Boonsboro, Montvale, Shady Grove, Thaxton, Goode, Liberty High School, and Sign Rock Precincts and parts of the Forest and Jefferson Precincts; and part of Botetourt County comprised of the Amsterdam, Asbury, Town Hall, Blue Ridge, Rainbow Forest, Mill Creek, Roaring Run, Buchanan 301/Springwood 304, Courthouse, Eagle Rock, Glen Wilton, Oriskany, and Troutville Precincts.

Twenty-second. All of Campbell County; and part of Bedford County comprised of the Chamblissburg, Staunton River, Moneta, Mountain View, New London, Walton's Store, White House, and Huddleston Precincts and parts of the Forest and Jefferson Precincts.

Twenty-third. All of the City of Lynchburg; and part of Amherst County comprised of the Wright Shop and Coolwell Precincts and part of the Amelon and Monroe Precincts.

Twenty-fourth. All of Rockbridge County; all of the Cities of Buena Vista and Lexington; part of Amherst County comprised of the New Glasgow, Courthouse, Temperance, Elon, Pleasant View, and Madison Precincts and part of the Amelon and Monroe Precincts; and part of Augusta County comprised of the Middlebrook, Spottswood, White Hill, and Sherando Precincts.

Twenty-fifth. All of the City of Waynesboro; part of Albemarle County comprised of parts of the North Garden 302/Batesville 303 and Crozet Precincts; part of Augusta County comprised of the Verona, Crimora, New Hope, Weyers Cave, Fort Defiance, Lyndhurst, Dooms, Fishersville, and Wilson Precincts; and part of Rockingham County comprised of the Mill Creek, Grottoes, Elkton, McGaheysville, and South Fork Precincts.

Thirtieth. All of Culpeper and Madison Counties; and part of Orange County comprised of the One East, Two East, Three, Four, Locust Grove, and Lake of the Woods Precincts, and parts of the One West and Two West Precincts.

Thirty-first. Part of Fauquier County comprised of the Kettle Run, Catlett, Casanova, and New Baltimore Precincts and part of the Baldwin Ridge Precinct; and part of Prince William County

60 Forty-seventh. Part of Arlington County comprised of the Ashton Heights, Ballston, Barcroft,
 61 Clarendon, Lyon Park, Overlee Knolls, Westover, Arlington Forest, Fillmore, Jefferson, Dominion Hills,
 62 Lexington, Arlington View, Ashlawn, Virginia Square, and Woodbury Precincts and part of the Glen
 63 Carlyn Precinct.

64 Forty-ninth. Part of the City of Alexandria comprised of the Cora Kelly Center and Mt. Vernon
 65 Recreation Center Precincts; part of Arlington County comprised of the Arlington, Columbia, Claremont,
 66 Glebe, and Oakridge Precincts and part of the Glen Carlyn Precinct; and part of Fairfax County
 67 comprised of the Baileys Precinct and parts of the Glen Forest and Holmes Precincts.

68 Fifty-first. Part of Prince William County comprised of the McCoart, Springwoods, Westridge, Lake
 69 Ridge, Occoquan, Old Bridge, Rockledge, Mohican, Civic Center, Kerrydale, Lynn, and Kilby Precincts
 70 and part of the Bethel, Chinn, and Minnieville Precincts.

71 Fifty-fourth. Part of Caroline County comprised of part of the Woodford Precinct; and part of
 72 Spotsylvania County comprised of the Travelers Rest, Maury, Summit, Frazers Gate, Belmont,
 73 Brokenburg, Todd's Tavern, Holbert, Salem, Battlefield, and Brent's Mill Precincts.

74 Fifty-fifth. Part of Hanover County comprised of the Ashland, South Ashland, Ashcake, Beaverdam,
 75 Blunts, Wilmington Parish, Goddin's Hill, Clay, Chickahominy, Shady Grove, Atlee, Cool Spring,
 76 Courthouse, Village, Mechanicsville, Farrington, Montpelier, Rockville, and Elmont Precincts and part of
 77 the Rural Point 502/Newman 503 Precinct.

78 Fifty-seventh. All of the City of Charlottesville; and part of Albemarle County comprised of the
 79 Commonwealth, Branchlands, and Ivy Precincts and parts of the Agnor-Hurt, Jack Jouett, University
 80 Hall, and Free Bridge Precincts.

81 Fifty-eighth. All of Greene County; part of Albemarle County comprised of the Woodbrook, East
 82 Ivy, Monticello, Keswick, Stony Point, Hollymead, Free Union, and Earlysville Precincts and parts of
 83 the Agnor-Hurt, Jack Jouett, Scottsville, Cale, Free Bridge, University Hall, and Crozet Precincts; part of
 84 Fluvanna County comprised of the Palmyra and Rivanna Precincts and part of the Cunningham Precinct;
 85 and part of Orange County comprised of *parts of the One West Precinct and Two West Precincts*.

86 Fifty-ninth. All of Appomattox, Buckingham, Cumberland and Nelson Counties; part of Albemarle
 87 County comprised of the Porter's and Covesville Precincts and parts of the North Garden 302/Batesville
 88 303, Scottsville and Cale Precincts; part of Fluvanna County comprised of the Columbia and Fork Union
 89 Precincts and part of the Cunningham Precinct; and part of Prince Edward County comprised of the
 90 Prospect Precinct and parts of the Buffalo Heights and West End Precincts.

91 Sixtieth. All of Charlotte and Halifax Counties; part of Nottoway County comprised of Precinct 1-1
 92 and Precinct 3-1 Part 2; and part of Prince Edward County comprised of the Farmville, Lockett, Leigh,
 93 Hampden, Darlington Heights, and Center Precincts and parts of the Buffalo Heights and West End
 94 Precincts.

95 Sixty-first. All of Amelia and Mecklenburg Counties; part of Brunswick County comprised of the
 96 Tillman and Dromgoole Precincts and part of the Brodnax and Rock Store Precincts; part of Lunenburg
 97 County comprised of the Plymouth, Brown's Store, McCoy Ghee's Store, Arrowhead Gun Club, Pleasant
 98 Grove, Reedy Creek, Peoples Community Center, Meherrin Fire Dept, and Courthouse Precincts; and
 99 part of Nottoway County comprised of Precinct 1-2, Precinct 2-1, Precinct 2-2, Precinct 3-2, Precinct
 100 4-1, Precinct 4-2, Precinct 5-1, and Precinct 3-1 Part 1.

101 Sixty-second. Part of Chesterfield County comprised of the Enon, Point Of Rocks, and Salem Church
 102 Precincts and part of the Bellwood Precinct; part of Henrico County comprised of the Town Hall,
 103 Sandston, Seven Pines, Whitlocks, and Dorey Precincts; part of the City of Hopewell comprised of the
 104 Ward 3, Ward 4, and Ward 5 Precincts and parts of the Ward 1, Ward 6, and Ward 7 Precincts; and
 105 part of Prince George County comprised of the Richard Bland College, Templeton, Union Branch,
 106 Rives, Blackwater, Brandon, Jefferson Park, and Bland Precincts and part of the Courts Building
 107 Precinct.

108 Sixty-fourth. All of Surry County; all of the City of Williamsburg; part of the City of Franklin
 109 comprised of part of Precinct 1-1; part of Isle of Wight County comprised of the Smithfield, Carrollton,
 110 Rushmere, Pons, Courthouse, Windsor, Orbit, Walters, Carrsville, and Zuni Precincts; part of James City
 111 County comprised of the Jamestown A, Jamestown B, and Jamestown C Precincts and parts of the
 112 Berkeley A, Berkeley B, Powhatan A, Powhatan B, and Roberts A Part 1 Precincts; and part of
 113 Southampton County comprised of the Hunterdale and Sedley Precincts.

114 Seventy-fourth. All of Charles City County; part of Henrico County comprised of the Adams, Azalea,
 115 Bloomingdale, Brook Hill, Canterbury, Chamberlayne, East Highland Park, Fairfield, Glen Lea,
 116 Greenwood, Highland Gardens, Hungary, Longdale, Randolph, Ratcliffe, Upham, Wilkinson, Yellow
 117 Tavern, Maplewood, Chipplegate, Landmark, Cedar Fork, Donahoe, Elko, Fairmount, Highland Springs,
 118 and Pleasants Precincts; part of the City of Hopewell comprised of the Ward 2 Precinct and parts of the

119 Ward 1, Ward 6, and Ward 7 Precincts; part of the City of Richmond comprised of the 604 Precinct;
120 and part of Prince George County comprised of part of the Courts Building Precinct.

121 Seventy-fifth. All of Greenville and Sussex Counties; all of the City of Emporia; part of Brunswick
122 County comprised of the Edgerton, Fitzhugh, Alberta, Danielstown, Elmore, Seymour, Sturgeon, King's
123 Store, and Lawrenceville Precincts and part of the Brodnax and Rock Store Precincts; part of the City of
124 Franklin comprised of Precinct 2-1, Precinct 3-1, Precinct 4-1, Precinct 5-1, and Precinct 6-1 and part of
125 Precinct 1-1; part of Isle of Wight County comprised of the Camps Mill Precinct; part of Lunenburg
126 County comprised of the Parham's Store and Hound's Creek Precincts; and part of Southampton County
127 comprised of the Berlin, Ivor, Boykins, Branchville, Capron, Sebrell, Drewryville, Forks-of-the-River,
128 Courtland, Blackwater River, and Newsoms Precincts.

129 Seventy-sixth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Churchland, Gilmerton, Jolliff One,
130 Fellowship Baptist Church, Silverwood, Bailey Creek, Lake Drummond, John T. West, Deep Creek, and
131 Nansemond Precincts; and part of the City of Suffolk comprised of the Driver, Ebenezer, Chuckatuck,
132 King's Fork, Whaleyville, Holland, Holy Neck, Lakeside, Elephant's Fork, and Lake Meade Precincts
133 and parts of the Cypress Chapel, Harbour View, Kilby's Mill, Nansemond River, Olde Towne, and
134 Yeates Precincts.

135 Seventy-seventh. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Camelot, Crestwood, Oscar Smith
136 School, Geneva Park, Georgetown, E. W. Chittum School, St. Julians, Sunray I, South Norfolk Fire
137 Station, Carver School, Providence Church of Christ, Westover, Sunray II, and South Norfolk Recreation
138 Precincts; and part of the City of Suffolk comprised of the White Marsh, John F. Kennedy, Airport, and
139 Hollywood Precincts and part of the Cypress Chapel, Kilby's Mill, and Olde Towne Precincts.

140 Seventy-ninth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Taylor Road Fire Station Precinct;
141 part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Larchmont Library and Larchmont Recreation Center
142 Precincts and parts of the Canterbury, Titustown Center, and Zion Grace Precincts; part of the City of
143 Portsmouth comprised of the Ten, Eleven, Twenty-Two, Twenty-Three, Twenty-Four, Twenty-Five,
144 Thirty, Thirty-Three, Thirty-Four, Thirty-Five, Thirty-Six, and Thirty-Seven/Thirty-Eight Precincts; and
145 part of the City of Suffolk comprised of parts of the Harbor View, Nansemond River, and Yeates
146 Precincts.

147 Eighty-seventh. Part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Northside, Crossroads, Therapeutic
148 Center, Wesley, Bayview United, East Ocean View, Larrymore, Little Creek, Oceanair, Tarrallton, Third
149 Presbyterian, and Ocean View Center Part 2 Precincts and parts of the Azalea Gardens, Barron Black,
150 Bayview School, Granby, Ocean View Center Part 1, Ocean View School, Titustown Center, Tucker
151 House and Zion Grace Precincts.

152 Eighty-ninth. Part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Ghent Square, Immanuel, Lafayette
153 Library, Lafayette Presbyterian, Lambert's Point, Maury, Park Place, Stuart, Suburban Park, Willard,
154 Ballentine, Tanner's Creek, Coleman Place School, Lafayette-Winona, Lindenwood, Monroe, Norview
155 Methodist, Norview Recreation Center, Rosemont, Sherwood School, and Young Park Precincts and
156 parts of the Granby, Hunton Y, Sherwood Rec Center Part 2, and Tucker House Precincts.

157 Ninetieth. Part of the City of Chesapeake comprised of the Indian River, Norfolk Highlands,
158 Oaklette, and Tanglewood Precincts; part of the City of Norfolk comprised of the Bowling Park, Union
159 Chapel, Brambleton, Campostella, Chesterfield, Coleman Place Presbyterian, Easton, Fairlawn, Houston,
160 Ingleside, Poplar Halls, and Sherwood Rec Center Part 1 Precincts and parts of the Azalea Gardens,
161 Barron Black, and Sherwood Rec Center Part 2 Precincts; and part of the City of Virginia Beach
162 comprised of the Baker Precinct.

163 Ninety-seventh. All of New Kent County; part of Caroline County comprised of the Madison and
164 Reedy Church Precincts and parts of the Mattaponi and Woodford Precincts; part of Hanover County
165 comprised of the Battlefield, Old Church, Cold Harbor, Black Creek, Studley, and Stonewall Jackson
166 Precincts and part of the Rural Point 502/Newman 503 Precinct; part of Henrico County comprised of
167 the Chickahominy, Nine Mile, and Antioch Precincts; part of King and Queen County comprised of the
168 Owenton and Clark's Precincts; part of King William County comprised of the Second-B, Third, Fourth
169 and Fifth Precincts and part of the Second-A Precinct; and part of Spotsylvania County comprised of the
170 Partlow and Blaydes Corner Precincts.

171 Ninety-eighth. All of Essex, Gloucester, Mathews, and Middlesex Counties; part of King and Queen
172 County comprised of the Shackelford's, Courthouse, and Old Mill Precincts; and part of King William
173 County comprised of the First Precinct and part of the Second-A Precinct.

174 Ninety-ninth. All of King George, Lancaster, Northumberland, Richmond, and Westmoreland
175 Counties; and part of Caroline County comprised of the Bowling Green and Port Royal Precincts and
176 parts of the Mattaponi and Woodford Precincts.

177 All other House of Delegates districts shall be comprised as provided in § 24.2-304.01.

178 **2. That the effect of the first enactment shall be that the existing boundary line between the**
179 **Thirtieth and Fifty-eighth House of Delegates districts within Orange County shall be superseded**

180 by a boundary line described as follows:

181 Beginning at the point where James Madison Highway (United States Highway 15) intersects
182 the Orange County-Madison County boundary line, then southwest on James Madison Highway
183 to the northern corporate limits of the Town of Orange, counterclockwise on the northern and
184 then western corporate limits of the Town of Orange to Constitution Highway (State Highway
185 20), west on Constitution Highway to Dolley Madison Road (State Route 675), south on Dolley
186 Madison Road to East Gate Road, west on East Gate Road to West Gate Road, southwest on
187 West Gate Road to Chicken Mountain Road (State Route 639), west on Chicken Mountain
188 Road to Jacksontown Road (State Route 655), south and then west on Jacksontown Road to
189 Blue Ridge Turnpike (State Highway 231), south on Blue Ridge Turnpike to Spotswood
190 Trail/North Main Street (United States Highway 33), southeast on Spotswood Trail/North Main
191 Street to the corporate limits of the Town of Gordonsville, counterclockwise on the Town of
192 Gordonsville corporate limits to Gordon Avenue (State Highway 231), and southwest on
193 Gordon Avenue to the Orange County-Louisa County boundary line.
