Limit on appropriations. 18 19 The General Assembly shall not make total appropriations for any fiscal year that exceed the total 20 appropriations for the immediately preceding fiscal year by the greater of (i) five percent or (ii) a 21 percentage equal to the percentage increase in the rate of inflation for the most recently available year, plus the percentage increase in state population, both as shall be defined by general law, except 22 23 appropriations made (a) for tax relief, (b) for deposits to the Revenue Stabilization Fund, or (c) for nonrecurring capital projects. For purposes of this section, "total appropriations" means all 24 25 appropriations except for any moneys appropriated that are received from the federal government or 26 agency or unit thereof. 27 The General Assembly shall enact such laws as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this 28 section.
