positive impact on the Commonwealth and the nation as adult citizens; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate
the Tuesday prior to Election Day each year as Youth Political Education Day in Virginia; and, be it
RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates post the designation of this day
