Patron Prior to Engrossment-Delegate Petersen 8 Referred to Committee on Rules 9 10 WHEREAS, April 30, 2005, marks the 30th Anniversary of the Vietnamese Diaspora; and WHEREAS, Virginia is home to a thriving community of over 44,907 Vietnamese Americans, 11 making the Commonwealth one of the top five population centers for Vietnamese Americans in the 12 United States; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Vietnamese Americans contribute to the economy of the Commonwealth with over 15 4,144 firms that generate \$317 million in sales and receipts; and WHEREAS, over 40 percent of Vietnamese Americans own their own homes and the median annual 16 income is \$46.929: and 17 18 WHEREAS, Vietnamese Americans fought alongside Virginians for freedom and democracy, ideals embodied in "sic semper tyrannis"; now, therefore, be it 19 20 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Vietnamese-American 21 community of Virginia be recognized following the 30th anniversary of the fall of Saigon and the Republic of South Vietnam [; and, be it 22 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit a copy of this resolution 23 24

24 to the Vietnamese-American community of Virginia requesting that a representative from this 25 community further disseminate copies of this resolution to their respective constituents so that they may
