2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-870 of the Code of Virginia, relating to speed limits.*

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6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-870 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-870. Maximum speed limits generally.

9 Except as otherwise provided in this article, the maximum speed limit shall be 55 miles per hour on  
10 interstate highways or other limited access highways with divided roadways, nonlimited access highways  
11 having four or more lanes, and all state primary highways.12 The maximum speed limit on all other highways shall be 55 miles per hour if the vehicle is a  
13 passenger motor vehicle, bus, pickup or panel truck, or a motorcycle, but 45 miles per hour on such  
14 highways if the vehicle is a truck, tractor truck, or combination of vehicles designed to transport  
15 property, or is a motor vehicle being used to tow a vehicle designed for self-propulsion, or a house  
16 trailer.17 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the maximum speed limit shall be 65 miles  
18 per hour where indicated by lawfully placed signs, erected subsequent to a traffic engineering study, on:  
19 (i) interstate highways, (ii) multilane, divided, limited access highways, and (iii) high-occupancy vehicle  
20 lanes if such lanes are physically separated from regular travel lanes. The maximum speed limit shall be  
21 60 miles per hour where indicated by lawfully placed signs, erected subsequent to a traffic engineering  
22 study, on *U.S. Route 29, U.S. Route 360, and U.S. Route 460* where ~~it is a~~ *they are* nonlimited access,  
23 multilane, divided ~~highway~~ *highways*.
