| 11 | 1. § 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of General Services shall conduct |
| 12 | public sales or auctions of the surplus property from the Virginia Capitol restoration and expansion |
| 13 | project. In addition, the Department shall provide for the sale of the chairs used in the chambers of the |
| 14 | houses to current and former members of the General Assembly in accordance with guidelines |
| 15 | established by the Clerk of the House of Delegates and the Clerk of the Senate. For purposes of this |
| 16 | section, "surplus property" means any personal property including, but not limited to, any fixture, |
| 17 | furnishing, material, supply, equipment, and recyclable item, that is determined to be salvageable |
| 18 | surplus property as agreed to by the Clerk of the House of Delegates, the Clerk of the Senate, and the |
| 19 20 | Secretary of Administration. There shall be appropriated to the Virginia Capitol Preservation |
| 20 | Foundation a sum sufficient appropriation equal to all of the proceeds of the sales to support the |
