Other comments: Under § 38.2-5021 of the Code of Virginia, the State Corporation Commission Bureau of Insurance is responsible for an actuarial analysis of the solvency of the Birth Related Neurological Injury Compensation Fund (Fund). According to the Bureau's actuarial consultants, there would be a reduction to the Fund's deficit of approximately \$20.8 million by Year End 2006 as a result of House Bill 1505 limiting the definition.
