**4. Title**            School property; allows local school boards to sell for transportation purposes.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

This bill empowers local school boards to sell property to the Virginia Department of Transportation or the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner when such conveyance is necessary for transportation purposes. Such transfers shall not require the exercise of eminent domain by the Commissioner.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Cannot be determined.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** There is no way to reliably estimate the number of school boards that might be affected by the provisions of this legislation. Any revenue generated from the sale of property would be retained by local school boards and deposited into a capital improvement fund.
