Motor vehicle daily rental fee. Provides that the daily rental vehicle fee will be implemented, enforced, and collected in the same manner as rental taxes.

**8. Fiscal implications:**

Enactment of this bill serves as a preventative measure in order to protect the revenue stream produced by the 2% rental fee by making a technical modification to the statute to appropriately clarify the administration of the fee. By clarifying the implementation, enforcement and collection of the fee, this bill minimizes the likelihood of challenges which could thwart collection of funds negatively impacting Treasury and the Statewide Agencies Radio System (STARS).
