5. Summary/Purpose: This bill extends from 2005 to 2010 the current sunset on the requirements that the Superintendent of Public Instruction annually survey school divisions to identify critical teacher shortage areas and report these shortages to the Virginia Retirement System (VRS) (§ 22.1-23).
