**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Allows free use of toll facilities by law-enforcement officers of the Virginia Marine Resources Commission. This privilege does not extend to the Chesapeake Bay Bridge-Tunnel or facilities controlled by the Richmond Metropolitan Authority.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Cannot be determined.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** There are currently 70 law-enforcement personnel employed by the Commission that could be impacted by this bill. However, there is no reliable way to estimate the potential loss of revenue to toll roads because the frequency of use by eligible employees is unknown at this time.
