**4. Title**            Lobbyist Disclosure and Regulation Act; reporting.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Changes from January 5 to December 15 the date on which registered lobbyists must provide statements to legislative and executive officials with whom they have lobbied. The bill also changes the reporting period for the statements from January 1 through December 31 to December 1 through November 30. This bill is a recommendation of HJR 186 (2004) Joint Subcommittee.
