**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill creates a Class 4 misdemeanor charge for anyone who knowingly makes a false statement concerning the residency of a child in a particular school division or school attendance zone for the purpose of evading the provisions of § 22.1-3.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** Anyone convicted of a Class 4 misdemeanor is subject to a fine of up to \$250. The number of people that might be convicted under such provisions is unknown which makes it impossible to reliably estimate how much additional revenue this bill would generate for the Commonwealth. Any revenues generated under this legislation would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
