4. Title Changes the Membership of the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission

5. Summary/Purpose:

This legislation changes the composition of the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission membership by two members to include the Chairman of the House Committee for Courts of Justice or his designee, in lieu of one of the three persons to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; and the Chairman of the Senate Committee for Courts of Justice or his designee, in lieu of one of the two persons to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules. This substitute also provides clarifying language that legislative members receive compensation as indicated by §30-19.12, and nonlegislative members citizen members receive compensation as provided in § 2.2-2813 and both receive necessary expenses as provided in §§2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825.
