4. Title Driver's license reinstatement fees.

5. Summary/Purpose:

This legislation proposes to amend and reenact § [46.2-411](#) of the Code of Virginia imposing an additional \$40 fee for reinstatement of suspended or revoked driver's licenses. Proceeds of this additional fee are to be paid into the Trauma Center Fund to defray the costs of providing emergency medical care to victims of automobile accidents attributable to alcohol or drug use.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final. See Item #8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: Yes. Item #307.

8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles advises that this legislation will have no fiscal impact upon that agency but will produce additional revenue for the Trauma Center Fund. The fund is administered as grants by the Department of Health per the authority of §18.2-270.01 of the Code of Virginia.

DMV advises that during CY 2004, 106,353 reinstatement fees were collected from all types of suspensions and revocations. With the final legislation setting the fee at \$40, the additional revenue is estimated at approximately \$4.3 million NGF.

The Conference Committee provided \$4.2 million in additional NGF appropriation for the Trauma Center Fund within the Department of Health.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Motor Vehicles, Department of Health, and the Trauma Center Fund.

10. Technical amendment necessary: None.
